

Client Pre-Surgery Information

It is important for you to understand that the risk of injury or death, although extremely low, is always present just as it is for humans who undergo surgery. Please carefully read the following.

- This operation presents some hazards and that injury to or death of an animal may conceivably result, for there is some risk in the procedure and the use of anesthetics and drugs in providing this service. Safe Paws cannot provide or pay for any aftercare in the event of any complications.
- Your animal should be in good health in order to undergo any surgical procedure and should not eat or drink after 8pm the night before surgery.
- Safe Paws and/or the participating clinic has the right to refuse service to any animal to whom surgery is deemed a health risk.
- Your animal may be exposed to other animals with unknown health histories with the potential for infectious disease.
- Safe Paws and/or the participating clinic has the right to refuse service to any animal that is deemed a risk to staff, volunteers, or other animals in the building.
- Some factors significantly increase surgical risk, including but not limited to, pregnancy, heat, obesity, age and diseases such as Feline Immunodeficiency Virus, Feline Leukemia, and Heartworm.
- You must pick up your animal by your designated pick up time. If you do not pick up your animal by this time, you will be charged a boarding fee of \$50.00 per animal.

- All services must be added prior to the day of your appointment.
Services may not be added to your appointment on the day of
surgery and must be paid for upon pick up.
